Water Project Discussion:

Council held a roundtable discussion to express their opinions regarding the recent proposals by CP&Y for arsenic mitigation. Many questions and concerns were raised about the proposals, especially pertaining to accuracy and cost projections. Randy Ehlers explained that he had recently talked to Bob Wallace at CP&Y regarding an alternative to both of those proposals. Randy's suggestion was to just put one filtration system at RMS instead of treating all three wells. Bob agreed that Randy was right about simplifying the project and was going to begin working on a new proposal which would involve just having ONE filtration system at RMS and sending arsenic free water to Riesel and to MS to be blended with their existing wells to bring the water into compliance levels. Bob said he thinks this will work. He's also going to make sure TCEQ approves of this option. Council would like to encourage RMS to hold a meeting to get more input from the other systems.
