

**Ordinance Number 2015-05**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS  
ADOPTING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riesel, Texas has considered a proposed operating budget for the municipal government of the City of Riesel, Texas for the fiscal year 2015-2016; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed operating budget after notice of the same was given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riesel, Texas after hearing the public on the issue and considering the said proposed operating budget, believes that the same should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS that the operating budget attached hereto as Appendix "A"( including its cover sheet), and incorporated by reference herein, is hereby adopted as the operating budget for the municipal government of the City of Riesel, Texas for the fiscal year 2015-2016, which begins on October 1, 2015 and ends on September 30, 2016.

This budget reflects increased tax revenues over last year's budget.


