

BE IT REMEMBERED that on **MAY 19, 2026**, the Riesel City Council met in a **REGULAR** scheduled meeting, at 6:30 p.m. in the Riesel City Hall Meeting Room, at 104 Hwy. 6 North in Riesel, Texas, with notice of the meeting having been posted in accordance with Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

Call to Order: Mayor Jennifer Hogg called the meeting to order at 6:31 PM

Council Members Present: Bobby Dieterich, Paul Winkler, Kevin Wunderlich, Debbie Kilgore & Glenna Sandhoff

Employees Present: Alisha Flanary, Chelsea Kemp, Randy Ehlers, Patrick Bellringer, Ryan Dieterich

Mayor Hogg led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

Consent Items: Paul Winkler made a motion to approve the consent agenda consisting of the minutes from 4/23/2026 and 5/8/2026, the payment of bills, payroll, the monthly financial reports and payment of invoice #24509 for legal services from Haley & Olson for the Arsenic Mitigation Project (alluvium well) in the amount of \$10,710.00. Kevin Wunderlich seconded the motion and it carried, unanimously.

Visitors' Comments: Kathy Fryer addressed the council regarding her concerns over a utility easement.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: at 6:50 pm, Council Members convened into a closed meeting pursuant to Section 551.074 of the Government Code (V.C.T.A.) for the City Council to deliberate the duties, evaluation, employment, and/or appointment of a public officer or employee: **Chelsea Kemp**

At 7:18 PM, Council reconvened in open session. No action was taken during executive session.

Salary Increase: Glenna Sandhoff moved to increase Chelsea Kemp's salary by 2.9%. Debbie Kilgore seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Easement: Before discussion of this item began, Council Member Debbie Kilgore disclosed a family relationship with the property owner requesting the release of a city easement, and she filed the required affidavit in accordance with Section 176.003 of the Texas Local Government Code and abstained from discussion and action on the item.

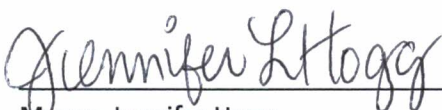
Paul Winkler moved to release a sanitary sewer easement dated February 27, 1970, given by "GRANTOR" Floyd Fryar, and signed by Mrs. Floyd Fryar, and recorded April 2, 1970 at Volume 1070, Pages 132-133, of the Deed Records of McLennan County, Texas. Glenna Sandhoff gave a second and the motion carried with four (4) ayes and one (1) abstention (Council Member Debbie Kilgore).

Sewer Plant Generator: Debbie Kilgore moved to authorize the purchase and installation of a generator for the Wastewater Treatment Plant on Kattner Road, with payment due upon completed installation after October 1, 2026. Paul Winkler seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

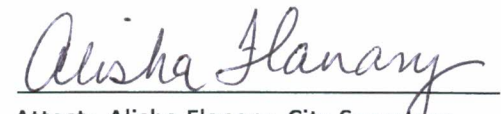
Monthly reports were submitted by department heads Randy Ehlers, Ryan Dieterich, and Alisha Flanary
