

Ordinance Number 2014-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS
ADOPTING THE OPERATING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riesel, Texas has considered a proposed operating budget for the municipal government of the City of Riesel, Texas for the fiscal year 2014-2015; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed operating budget after notice of the same was given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riesel, Texas after hearing the public on the issue and considering the said proposed operating budget, believes that the same should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS that the operating budget attached hereto as Appendix "A" (including its cover sheet), and incorporated by reference herein, is hereby adopted as the operating budget for the municipal government of the City of Riesel, Texas for the fiscal year 2014-2015, which begins on October 1, 2014 and ends on September 30, 2015.

This budget reflects increased tax revenues over last year's budget. The adopted tax rate will remain unchanged from last year, however property tax valuations have increased and therefore that same tax rate will generate increased tax revenues from last year's level.
