## ORDINANCE 2005-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS, THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE, CHAPTER 2, SUB CHAPTER C WHICH GIVES THE GOVERNING BODY OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THE AUTHORITY TO DECLARE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES ELECTED WITHOUT HAVING TO CONDUCT AN ELECTION IF THE SOLE PURPOSE OF THE ELECTION IS TO ELECT OFFICERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY, NO SEAT IS CONTESTED, THE WRITE-IN FILING DEADLINE HAS PASSED, AND NO PROPOSITION APPEARS ON THE BALLOT; AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE WAS ADOPTED WAS NOTICED AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS:

**Section 1:** That on January 6, 2004, the Riesel City Council adopted an Ordinance calling a General Election to be held in the City of Riesel, on May 7, 2005, for the purpose of electing a two councilpersons.

Section 2: That the following list contains all names of candidates for election:

Councilperson Steve Mullens

Councilperson Jamie Herring

**Section 3:** That the filing deadline for write-in candidates has passed and there are no propositions to appear on the ballot. The City Secretary has certified in writing that each candidate is unopposed for each office.

**Section 4:** That said election was duly called and that notice of said election was given in accordance with the law. The Riesel City Council, pursuant to Senate Bill 680, declares the following candidates duly elected Councilpersons of the City of Riesel, Texas, subject to taking of the oath as provided by laws of the State of Texas:

Councilperson Steve Mullens Councilperson Jamie Herring

**Section** 5: That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law.
