## ORDINANCE NO. 2007-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 12<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MAY, 2007, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON THE REAUTHORIZING OF A ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS; DESIGNATING A POLLING PLACE; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to Section 327.007 of the Tax Code, a municipal election is hereby called and ordered for the 12th day of May, 2007, at which election all qualified voters residing within the corporate limits of the City may vote for or against reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Riesel at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

That the city polling places for the voting will be at Riesel Independent School District, 600 East Frederick.

**Section 3.** That notice of the election shall be given as provided by law.

Section 4. The City Secretary shall receive mail in applications for a ballot to be voted by mail beginning Tuesday, March 13th until the close of business on Wednesday, April 4. 2007. Requests for applications should be mailed to: Bill McLelland, City Secretary, City of Riesel, PO Box 249, Riesel, Texas 76682; or requested by phone at 254.896.6501. Early voting by personal appearance begins Monday, April 30 until the close of business on Tuesday, May 8, 2007.
