

BE IT REMEMBERED that on **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2026**, the Riesel City Council met in a **SPECIAL CALLED MEETING** at 6:30 p.m. in the Riesel City Hall Meeting Room, 104 Hwy. 6 North, Riesel, Texas, with notice of the meeting having been posted at least three business days before the scheduled date of the meeting in accordance with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Call to Order: Mayor Jennifer Hogg called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

Council Members Present: Bobby Dieterich, Debbie Kilgore, Paul Winkler, Kevin Wunderlich, and Glenna Sandhoff

Employees Present: Alisha Flanary, Ryan Dieterich & Patrick Bellringer

Visitors Present: David Marek, Ryan Shellberg

Mayor Hogg led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the invocation.

PUBLIC HEARING: At 6:32 p.m., Mayor Hogg opened a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed 2026-2027 Ad Valorem Tax Rate. Staff and Council briefly reviewed the proposed rate and there were no public comments on the matter. Mayor Hogg closed the hearing at 6:34 p.m.

2026-2027 BUDGET: Staff and Council had final discussions regarding the proposed FY 2026-2027 Operating Budget. Paul Winkler moved to adopt **Ordinance No. 2026-08**, adopting the City of Riesel FY 2026-2027 Operating Budget as presented. Kevin Wunderlich seconded the motion. The record vote was: Dieterich – Aye; Kilgore – Aye; Winkler – Aye; Wunderlich – Aye; Sandhoff – Aye. Motion carried 5-0.

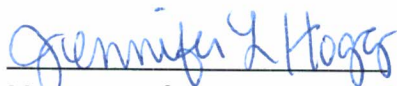
RATIFICATION OF TAX INCREASE: Paul Winkler made a motion to ratify the property tax revenue increase reflected in the adopted FY 2026-2027 Operating Budget. Debbie Kilgore seconded the motion. The record vote was: Dieterich – Aye; Kilgore – Aye; Winkler – Aye; Wunderlich – Aye; Sandhoff – Aye. Motion carried 5-0.

2026 AD VALOREM TAX RATE:

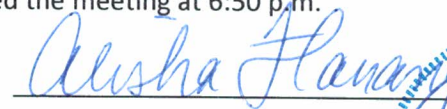
- a. **M&O Rate:** Debbie Kilgore moved to approve the Maintenance and Operations (M&O) component of \$0.202049 per \$100 valuation, as set forth in proposed Ordinance No. 2026-09 establishing the 2026 ad valorem tax rate. Glenna Sandhoff seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
- b. **Debt Rate:** Bobby Dieterich moved to approve the debt-service component of \$0.069441 per \$100 valuation, as set forth in proposed Ordinance No. 2026-09 establishing the 2026 ad valorem tax rate. Kevin Wunderlich seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
- c. **Total Tax Rate/Adoption of Ordinance:** Paul Winkler moved to adopt Ordinance No. 2026-09, establishing the City of Riesel's 2026 ad valorem tax rate at \$0.271490 per \$100 valuation, consisting of an M&O rate of \$0.202049 and a debt-service rate of \$0.069441. The adopted total tax rate is equal to the no-new-revenue tax rate. Debbie Kilgore seconded the motion. The record vote was: Dieterich – Aye; Kilgore – Aye; Winkler – Aye; Wunderlich – Aye; Sandhoff – Aye. Motion carried 5-0.

BROOKSHIRE/BEAVER PLAT: Paul Winkler moved to approve the Brookshire/Beaver plat subject to the conditions set forth in the August 25, 2026 review letter from City Engineer David Marek of STV Engineers. Kevin Wunderlich seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.

Adjournment: With no further business, Mayor Hogg adjourned the meeting at 6:50 p.m.
