

Ordinance No. 2010-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS, DIRECTING THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO ERECT CHILDREN AT PLAY SIGNS AT THE FOLLOWING DESIGNATED LOCATIONS OF RATTLESNAKE ROAD, SANDERS LANE, AND BROADWAY PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that , to protect the health and safety of its citizens, “Children at Play” signs should be erected on Rattlesnake Road, Sanders Lane, and Broadway;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that “Children at Play” signs should be erected at the points designated on the roadways listed below due to the concentration of residences in those areas in order to warn and remind drivers that children may be present so that they will drive accordingly. The City council hereby directs the public works Director to erect “Children at Play” signs at the following locations:

Rattlesnake Road Southbound approximately 444 feet south of Little Rattler

Rattlesnake Road Northbound approximately 548 feet south of Sanders Lane

Sanders Lane Eastbound approximately 386 feet east of Rattlesnake Road

Broadway Northbound approximately 500 feet north of Roadrunner Trail

Broadway Southbound approximately 370 feet south from the northside of the cemetery

such signs intended to make clear the presence of children in those areas.


SECTION 2. All provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Riesel, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. If any article, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgement or holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
