Canvass Election: Roger Fitzpatrick moved to approve Resolution #2023-1115-1 canvassing the returns of the General Election of November 7, 2023 for the purpose of electing three at large Council Members and declaring Ralph May, Bobby Dieterich and Paul Winkler officially elected. Secretary Flanary thanked the outgoing members for their service, commitment and for volunteering their time.

Appointment of Officers: Ralph May made a motion to appoint Jennifer Hogg as Mayor Pro Tem. With a second from Bobby Dieterich, the motion carried with one (1) Nay by Dustin Keller. Paul Winkler then made a motion to appoint Bobby Dieterich as Treasurer. Ralph May seconded the motion, which carried with one (1) Nay by Dustin Keller.

Consent Items: Jennifer Hogg made a motion to approve the consent items: Minutes from 10/10/23; monthly financial reports and the payment of bills. With a second by Paul Winkler the motion carried unanimously.

Visitor's Comments:

Renovations at Appraisal District: Paul Winkler made a motion to approve Resolution #2023-1115-3, approving the renovation and construction of an addition to the McLennan County Appraisal District office and that they finance the renovation and construction of an addition to its appraisal office. Jennifer Hogg seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Sewer Gas: Discussion was held with Mr. Bailey, Earlene Neumann, Courtney Cormier and Ron Horten regarding the ongoing sewer gas odor in their homes and outside their homes on Charles Street and South Hedwig. They were invited to attend a meeting with city engineers following the next smoke tests.

Pay Requests: Ralph May made a motion to hold off on pay request to JNB Construction until smoke tests could be done to ensure that there were no issues with the sewer line or manholes possibly leaking sewer gas. Jennifer Hogg seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

RE: SMOKE TEST RESULTS

Dear Homeowner,

As you probably know, there has been an ongoing sewer odor in your neighborhood for quite some time. The city has recently completed the replacement of a cracked sewer line on Charles Street as well as replacing several manholes. We've spend hundreds of thousands of dollars on this project and we are committed to reducing the pungent odors.

After that project completion, the City of Riesel conducted further smoke testing of the sewer lines in your area. A copy of the smoke test results are enclosed with this letter.

As you can see, there were several instances where visible smoke was coming from residential properties. Anywhere smoke is visible, sewer gas is escaping into the air. In addition to this, there was a city manhole with built in holes in the lid that had smoke escaping into that area as well. The city is plugging those holes to further reduce the gas from your area, but we are asking that you take action to remedy leaks on your property as well.

This includes checking for open cleanouts, clogged or damaged vent pipes, loose fitting connections, cracked or broken lines, lines that have separated at the joints, vents that are not properly installed to vent out above the roofline and checking waxrings on all toilets.

Even a hairline crack can release gas into your home or yard. The gas always follows the path of least resistance and if you have any cracks, crushed or root infiltrated pipes, or even a tiny leak in a wax ring, you will get sewer gas coming into your home.

And, if the smoke was visible outside, your neighbors are also affected by it. It can hover in the area for quite some time and be blown into their homes and pulled in through their ventilation systems. So, the sooner the repairs can be made, the less sewer gas there will be surrounding your homes.

The city is also in the process of getting further recommendations and proposals from our engineers. We hope to improve the situation, but it will take all of us doing our part to make a real difference.

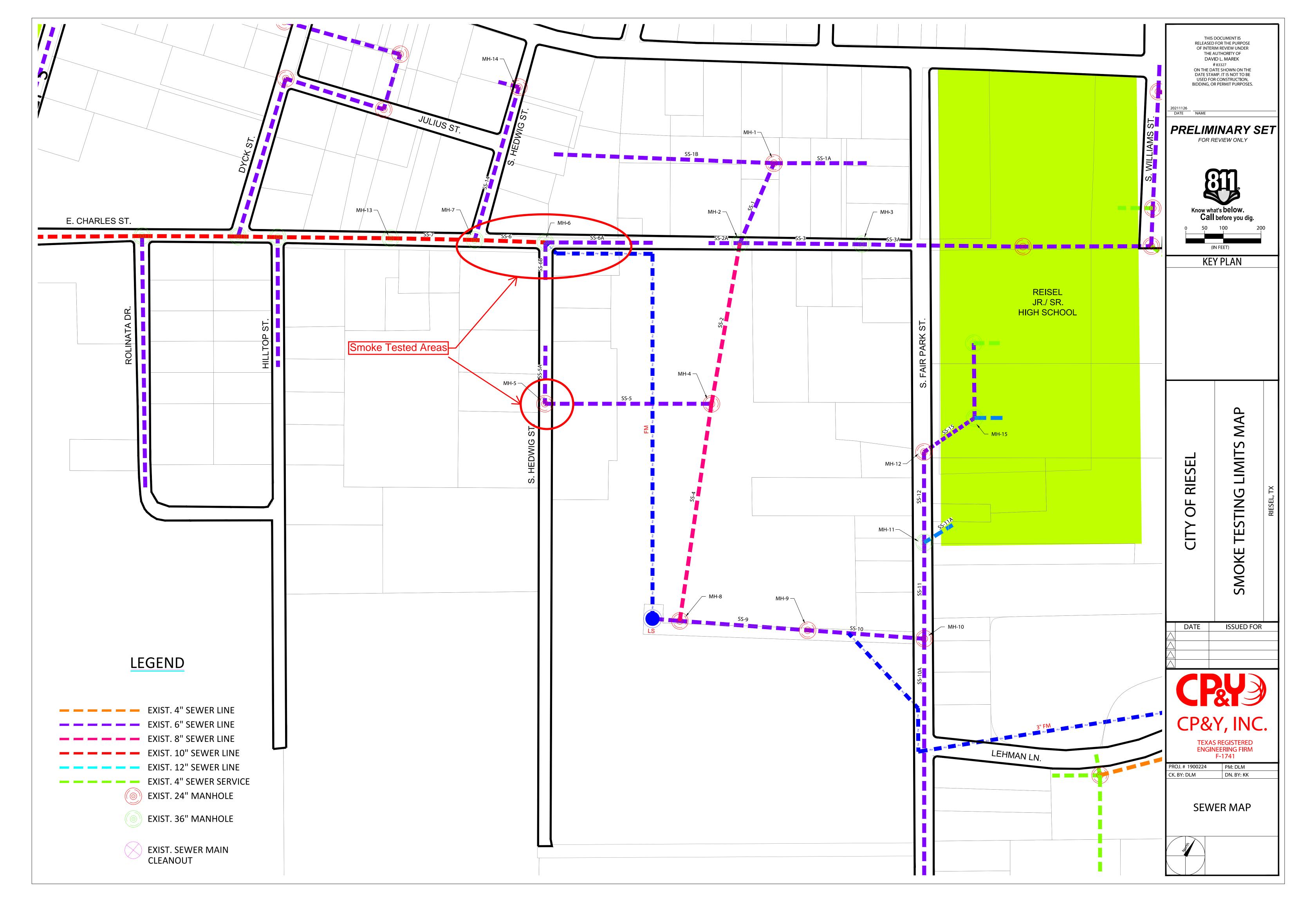

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT FOR THE COLLECTION, HAULING, AND DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE AND CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE, IN THE CITY OF RIESEL, TEXAS

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF MCLENNAN

This First Amendment to the Exclusive Franchise Agreement for the Collection, Hauling and Disposal of Municipal Solid Waste and Construction and Demolition Waste, in the City of Riesel, Texas (this "Amendment") is made and entered into as of the 1st day of January, 2024 (the "Amendment Date"), by and between Frontier Texas Ventures I, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company authorized to do business in Texas as "Frontier Waste Solutions" (the "Service Provider"), and the City of Riesel, Texas (the "City"), each individually a "Party" and collectively the "Parties".

WHEREAS, Frontier Access, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company and predecessor-ininterest to the Service Provider, and the City entered into that certain Exclusive Franchise Agreement for the Collection, Hauling and Disposal of Municipal Solid Waste and Construction and Demolition Waste, in the City of Riesel, Texas (the "Franchise Agreement") as of January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend the Franchise Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for the foregoing recitals and the mutual covenants and agreements of the Parties set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree to amend the Franchise Agreement by:

1. <u>Amendments</u>. The Franchise Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

(a) The term of the Franchise Agreement is hereby extended for an additional five (5) years, ending on December 31, 2028.

(b) The exclusive franchise grant set forth in Section 2 of the Franchise Agreement is hereby amended to except the collection, hauling and disposal of Construction and Demolition Waste in Roll-Offs with respect to services provided for short-term projects, such as construction or demolition projects ("Temporary Roll-Off Services"). For clarity, the exclusive franchise grant in favor of the Service Provider shall continue to apply to all Construction and Demolition Waste collected and hauled in Roll-Offs except with respect to Temporary Roll-Off Services.

(c) As of the Amendment Date, the rates and fees for the Services will be as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.

(d) All references in the Franchise Agreement to the Service Provider shall refer to Frontier Texas Ventures I, LLC.

2. No Other Amendments. Except as specifically provided in this Amendment, no other amendments, revisions, or changes are made or have been made to the Franchise Agreement. All other terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement remain in full force and effect and the Parties hereby ratify and confirm their respective rights, obligations, and representations under the Franchise Agreement, as amended.

3. Counterparts. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be considered an original instrument, but all of which shall be considered one and the same agreement and shall become binding when one or more counterparts have been signed by each of the Parties delivered to each of them.

4. Successors and Assigns. This Amendment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefits of the Parties hereto, their respective legal representatives, successors in title, and assigns.
