**Consent Items:** Todd Ehlers made a motion to approve Minutes from 4/19/22. Marshall Shaw seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

**Visitor's Comments:** Earlene Neumann said she wanted to thank the Council for working on the sewer odor problem on Charles Street and stated that they no longer notice a smell in that area.

**Sewer Rehab Project:** Todd Ehlers made a motion to accept a \$439,875 proposal by CP&Y for a sewer rehabilitation project in the Charles Street area which would repair a sewer line and rehab 11 manholes (note: \$257,000 of this project is funded by a grant). Jeff Tanner seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**Alluvium Well:** A test well has been drilled on Joe Rice's property in Falls County and water quality testing will be underway in the next week or two. Additional test wells may be drilled soon as well.
