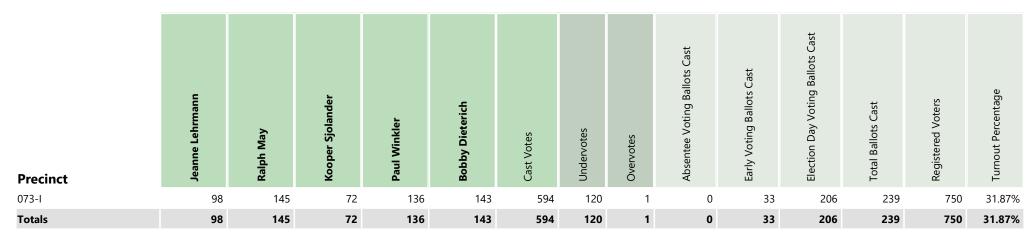

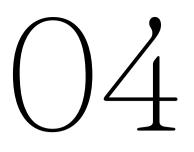

Call to Order: Mayor, Marshall Shaw, called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM

**Consent Items:** Jeanne Lehrmann made a motion to approve the consent items: Minutes from 9/12/23; monthly financial reports and the payment of bills. With a second by Kooper Sjolander, the motion carried unanimously.

**Visitor's Comments:** Tony Gregory made comments regarding roll-off dumpster rentals. Linda Hogg asked who to call to report suspicious activity during the day. Ralph May asked why the promotion to sergeant was back on the agenda again so soon. Paul Winkler asked Council to restripe the parking lot.

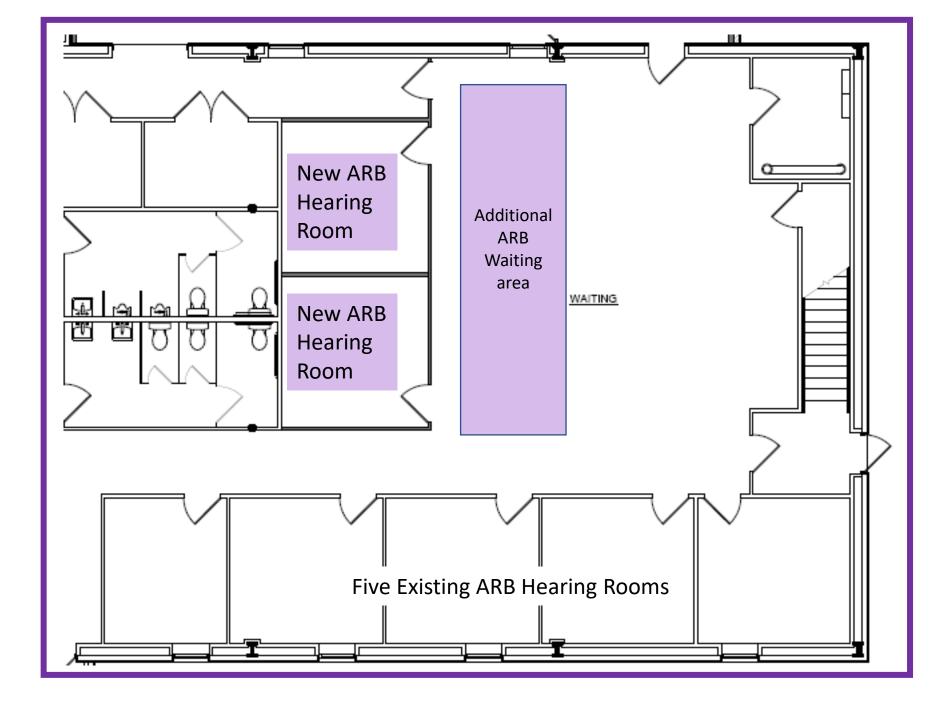
